**ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS**

Sealed Bids for the construction of the Sewerage System Improvements will be received, by City of Greenville, Georgia, at City Hall, 100 North Depot Street, Greenville, Georgia 30222, until 2:00 p.m. local time on Tuesday, December 5, 2017, at which time the Bids received will be publicly opened and read. No submitted bid may be withdrawn after the scheduled closing time for receipt of bids for a period of ninety (90) days. The Project consists of construction of:

Division One – Additions to Water Pollution Control Plant: Additions to the water pollution control plant to include construction of a screen and grit structure, a treatment plant complete with two trains of aeration basins, clarifiers and digesters, an ultraviolet disinfection system, a plant pump station, a sludge dewatering building, a control building, modifications to the control building, all complete with appurtenances.

Division Two – Modifications to Pump Stations: Modifications to the Dukes, Fuller and Dogwood pump stations, all complete with appurtenances

Division Three – Sewerage System Rehabilitation: Rehabilitation of the sewerage system including cleaning and televising and cured-in-place lining of approximately 12,350 linear feet of existing 8-inch and larger gravity sewer lines, all complete with appurtenances. Work also includes post-televising, point repairs, pavement repair, service connection repair, manhole construction and rehabilitation, bypass pumping and appurtenances.

Time of construction is 420 consecutive calendar days for substantial completion and 450 consecutive calendar days for final completion for Division One, 180 consecutive calendar days for substantial completion and 210 consecutive calendar days for final completion for Division Two, and 120 consecutive calendar days for substantial completion and 150 consecutive calendar days for final completion for Division Three.

Proposals for the complete work in one or more general contracts shall be made on the proposal form provided and shall contain prices in words and figures for the work bid on.

All Bidders must have a State of Georgia Utility Contractors License and must employ a state “Utility Manager” certificate holder who will have oversight of all the work.

Prospective Bidders may examine the Bidding Documents at the Issuing Office on Mondays through Fridays between the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. and may obtain copies of the Bidding Documents from the Issuing Office as described below.

Bidding Documents also may be examined at the office of the City of Greenville at Greenville City Hall, 100 North Depot Street, Greenville, Georgia 30222; Atlanta Builders Exchange in Atlanta, Georgia and the offices of the Engineer, Turnipseed Engineers, in Atlanta and Augusta on Mondays through Fridays between the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

Printed copies of the Bidding Documents may be obtained from the Issuing Office, during the hours indicated above, upon payment of a deposit of \$625.00 for the drawings and specifications for Divisions One, Two and Three, or a deposit of \$300.00 for the drawings and specifications for Divisions Two and Three only. An additional set of reduced drawings are available for \$450.00 for all divisions. The soils report is available for \$35.00. Bidders who return full sets of the Bidding Documents in good condition (suitable for re-use) within 30 days after receipt of Bids will receive a one-half (½) refund. Checks for Bidding Documents shall be payable to "Turnipseed Engineers". Upon request and receipt of the document deposit indicated above plus a non-refundable shipping charge, the Issuing Office will transmit the Bidding Documents. The date that the Bidding Documents are transmitted by the Issuing Office will be considered the Bidder's date of receipt of the Bidding Documents. *The difference between the deposit and the amount refunded represents the cost of reproduction. No refund will be made for documents received after thirty (30) days or in damaged condition.* Partial sets of Bidding Documents will not be available from the Issuing Office. Neither Owner nor Engineer will be responsible for full or partial sets of Bidding Documents, including Addenda if any, obtained from sources other than the Issuing Office.

A pre-bid conference will not be held.

Bid security shall be furnished in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders.

Bidders shall submit proof of qualifications to perform the Work as described in the Instructions to Bidders.
